UW LEND stands for the University of Washington Leadership Education in Neurodevelopmental and Related **D**isabilities. It is a training program where health professionals learn about each other to promote collaborative care for individuals with developmental disabilities. There are 13 core disciplines: Developmental Behavioral Pediatrics, Psychology, Nursing, Dentistry, Nutrition, Social Work, Audiology, Speech Language Pathology, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Special Education, Family Leadership, and Self-Advocacy.
