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Project Title: Literature Review of Feeding Support and Intervention for Young Children

Describe the Need:

Feeding and mealtime challenges are a common concern for families of children with and without disabilities. Multiple disciplines treat feeding disorders (occupational therapy, speech language pathology, medical, nutrition, applied behavior analysis, etc.). A multidisciplinary approach is important to treat different aspects of feeding and mealtime challenges. However, treatment often happens in isolation. It is important to understand skills that different involved disciplines bring to the table and how they can work together for a holistic approach.

Brief Description of Proposed Project:

A review of literature across disciplines to understand who treats various aspects of feeding challenges and strategies used, ending in a manuscript or annotated bibliography and proposal for a holistic approach.
