

The University of Washington Medical Center (UWMC) requires documentation of your immunizations to participate in clinical activities. Please obtain documentation of the vaccines listed below from your medical provider and submit to <a href="mailto:nan Ringera">nan Ringera</a>. \*Note: Self-reported vaccine history is not adequate.

## Before Orientation, provide documentation of these vaccinations:

- Rubeola and Mumps record of two vaccines with first dose on/after age one and second dose at least 28 days after first dose or positive IgG titer.
- Rubella record of one dose of Rubella vaccine or positive IgG titer.
- Varicella record of two vaccines with first dose on/after age one and second dose at least 28 days after first dose or positive IgG titer.
  \*Note: record of past infection is not sufficient documentation.
- **Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis** Record of single dose of Tdap vaccine **or** TD-containing vaccine (DTaP, DTP, TD, Tdap) within the last ten years.

## Optional: not required by UWMC but recommended:

- <u>COVID</u> is <u>NOT</u> required, however this vaccination is strongly encouraged.
- **Hepatitis B** is **NOT** required. UWMC advises that the exposure risk to Hepatitis B is low for observers, though UWMC does recommend having this vaccination.

## Following Orientation, provide documentation of Flu vaccine.

<u>Influenza</u> – a flu vaccine for the current season is required; you will be asked for proof of flu vaccination in October 2024.
